

## Directions to Allegheny General Hospital

### From the south:

- Take I-79 North to I-279.
- Follow I-279 North across the Fort Duquesne Bridge and take the East Ohio Street Exit (Exit 7C).
- Follow ramp and turn left towards I-279 North/East Ohio Street.
- Turn left onto East Ohio Street and follow to James Street.
- Turn right onto James Street and follow to East North Avenue.

### From the east:

- Take the I-76 Pennsylvania Turnpike Monroeville Exit (Exit 6) and follow I-376 West to Pittsburgh.
- Take the North Side/Stadiums Exit across Ft. Duquesne Bridge and follow I-279 North.
- Continue on I-279 North and take the East Ohio Street Exit (Exit 7C).
- Follow ramp and turn left towards I-279 North/East Ohio Street.
- Turn left onto East Ohio Street and follow to James Street.
- Turn right onto James Street and follow to East North Avenue.

### From the west:

- Take Route 60 to I-279 North toward Pittsburgh.
- Follow I-279 North and take the East Ohio Street Exit (Exit 7C).
- Follow ramp and turn left towards I-279 North/East Ohio Street.
- Turn left onto East Ohio Street and follow to James Street.
- Turn right onto James Street and follow to East North Avenue.

### From the northeast:

- Take Route 8 South to Route 28 South.
- Take Route 28 South and follow signs to East Ohio Street.
- Take East Ohio Street to James Street.
- Turn right onto James Street and follow to East North Avenue.

### From the north:

- Take I-79 South to I-279 South (Exit 72).
- Take I-279 South to the East Street/Route 28 North Exit (Exit 8B).
- Turn right onto East North Avenue.

## Visiting Hours

Hospital visiting hours for most patient units are from 1 to 8:30 p.m. Information regarding visiting hours for intensive care or specialty units may be obtained at the Information Desk in the Main Lobby, at a nurses' station or by calling 412-359-3131. Children under 14 are not permitted to visit patients, except on the Maternity Unit (with special arrangements). Families are not permitted to sleep in patient rooms or lounges; assistance in finding local accommodations is available (see Overnight Accommodations). To facilitate recovery, please limit the number of visitors per room and noise in rooms and halls.

## Admissions

As part of the admissions process, certain information is required and several forms must be completed as early as possible to comply with requirements of various insurance companies and other agencies. Call a Patient Access Services representative at 412-359-3061 at your earliest convenience, or if preferred you may visit the Admissions Department on the first floor of the hospital. The admissions process can be completed and questions regarding insurance coverage may be answered at that time.

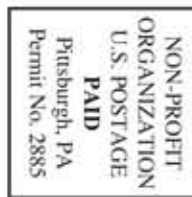

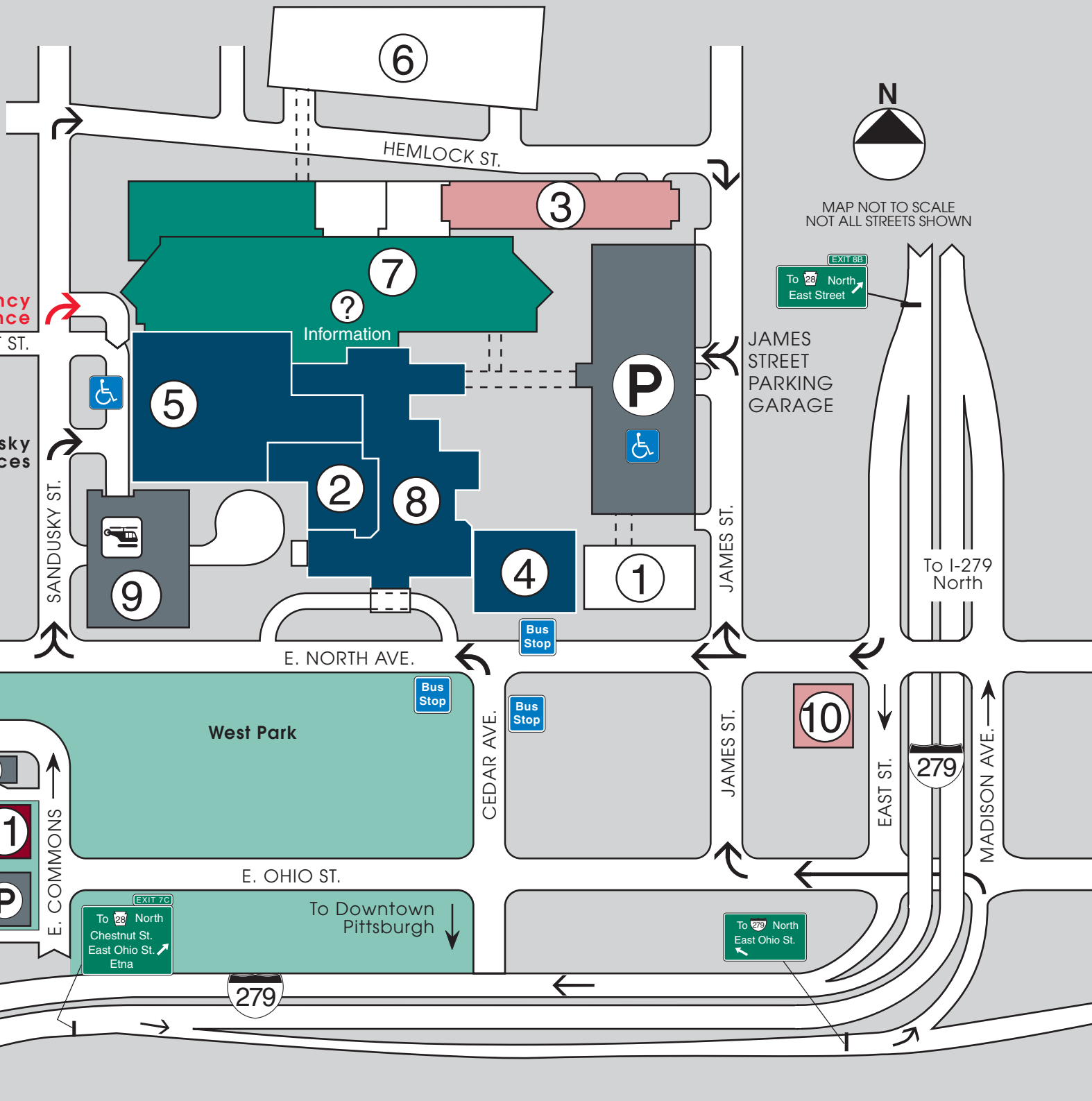

The hospital campus is located on the North Side of Pittsburgh, within one mile of downtown and the new stadiums.

## Ⓟ Parking

Parking is available for visitors and patients in the James Street Garage adjacent to the hospital. If a stay is lengthy, reduced rates for inpatients and their visitors may be arranged through Parking Services at 412-359-6816.

- Free parking for visitors picking up discharged inpatients is available through the Cashier's Office.
- Please take your parking ticket with you and pay inside the hospital before returning to your vehicle.

## ♿ Accessibility

Reserved parking spaces for the disabled are available in the James Street Garage. Disabled outpatient parking and the street entrance for the disabled are located at the patient entrance on Sandusky Street.

## Bus Stop Public Transportation

There are three Port Authority of Allegheny County (PAT) bus stops located at the intersection of East North Avenue and Cedar Avenue. The following routes provide service to the hospital:

## Outpatient Surgery

### Allegheny Outpatient Surgery Center

The Allegheny Outpatient Surgery Center is located on the 01 level of the East Wing. Free parking is available for these patients on the Ground Level of the Sandusky Street Garage.

### Ambulatory Care Center

The outpatients who are cared for in the Ambulatory Care Center include those undergoing surgical procedures, angiography, myelograms, bronchoscopy, lung and liver biopsy, chemotherapy, blood transfusion and various other procedures. If the patient requires an overnight stay in the hospital after the procedure, the patient will be admitted to another nursing unit of the hospital.

The Ambulatory Care Center is located on the 11-A floor of the Snyder Pavilion. Parking is provided in the James Street Parking Garage. Parking tickets will be validated within the center.

## Conference Center

The Conference Center located in the South Tower at Allegheny General has a 280-seat auditorium with advanced audio-visual and videoconferencing services. Parking is available in the James Street Garage adjacent to the hospital, unless directed otherwise.

## Overnight Accommodations

Through arrangements with area hotels, motels, inns and apartment complexes, Allegheny General Hospital is able to provide a list of housing accommodations for the patient, and the patient's family and friends. The housing facilities listed have made an effort to comply with our need for temporary housing for our visitors. All of the facilities are located within a four mile radius of Allegheny General along the major transportation corridors. Several facilities are within three blocks of the hospital and others, not as close, provide transportation to and from Allegheny General.

## Hospital Services

Hospital services include cafeteria, vending machines, automated teller machines and a gift shop. Other personal services offered include pastoral care, social service, dietary services, library services and patient representatives. The hospital is located near restaurants, places of worship and recreational activities.

Patients should bring personal hygiene supplies and a list of their medications. Please do not bring valuables, televisions or appliances.
